RESTRICTIONS IN IL: LEGAL TO CARRY IN A HOME OR BUSINESS ONLY IF THE PERSON POSSESSES AN FOID CARD.

Stun gun or taser = any device powered by electrical charging units which fires barbs and upon hitting a human sends out a current disrupting normal functioning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Cannot carry/possess unless at home or principal place of business (§ 5/24-1 and 5/24-1.6) •Sale restrictions (§ 5/24-3)

RESTRICTIONS IN CT: LEGAL ONLY IN HOME/RESIDENCE.

Connecticut	Legal	Legal only in home	Conn. Gen Stat. § 53a-3. Electronic defense weapon = a weapon which by electric impulse or current is capable of immobilizing a person temporarily, but is not capable of inflicting death or serious physical injury.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Carrying of electronic defense weapon unless peace officer is punishable by fine of less than \$500 or less than 3 years in prison or both (§ 53-206) •Cannot have in vehicle unless under specific circumstances (§ 29-38) •Criminal possession of electronic defense weapon is Class D felony (§ 53a-217)
